Mental Recall

- By the end of Year 4 national expectation is that all children can recall their number bonds and times tables up to 12x12
- All children have been individually assessed verbally on their mental recall
- From this the children all know their next step with their mental recall target
 Multiplication Tables Check Mathsframe

Mental recall expectations			
By the end of year 2	Addition and subtraction facts within 20 2 times table 5 times table 10 times table		
By the end of year 3	Doubles and halves within 100 3 times table 4 times table 8 times table 6 times table		
By the end of year 4	Recall all times tables up to 12x12		





- When we return in September, children will complete a star reading assessment on Accelerated Reader (AR) to find their reading range. The children are very familiar with these assessments.
- Following this, the children will choose books from the appropriate AR book level.
- As in Y3, when they have completed a book, they will take a test using AR.
- This enables us to ensure that children are comprehending what they have read, as well as accessing a range of genres and authors.



Home learning

Maths

Children will be expected to carry out deliberate practise on targets specific to them as well as working on their mental recall using <u>Multiplication Tables Check - Mathsframe</u>

Reading

Children should be reading daily for 30 minutes. When time allows they may read in class but the majority of this independent reading should be done at home.

Spelling

Weekly spellings from common exception words. These will be on spelling shed.
