f your child is learning to play a musical instrument in school the tuition fees have been added to your ParentPay account and are now due.


Fees can be paid upfront or instalments due during the first week of each term.

If your child's club falls on their P.E. day then they can simply stay in their P.E. kit. Should your child's club not coincide with their P.E. day then they can either bring their school kit to change in to, or some alternative sports clothing if they wish. This will help to prevent overuse of school P.E. kit.

For football after-school clubs, football boots and shinpads must be worn. For Cross-country, children may wear boots or trainers. However, the field usually becomes quite slippery and muddy so football/rugby boots are advisable. Please ensure children have a waterproof coat with them in case they require it.

#### **Attendance**

uring the meet the teacher sessions that were held for all classes in July, we outlined the Governments priority of regular school attendance. This message was again emphasised at the beginning of the week by Dame Rachel de Souza, the children's commissioner for England who said that persistent absence from school's was "one of the issues of our age" and called for a "razor sharp focus" on the problem.

We were very pleased that last year at Oakridge our school attendance was 95.7 % compared to the National attendance figure of 92.5% and the level of persistent absence - where pupils miss 10 per cent or more of school sessions — was 4.9% compared the National figure of 22.3%. Can I take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support it really is appreciated.

#### **School Registration**

Can we just remind parents that the school gates open at 8:45am and the school bell is rung at 8:55 when class registers close. Any child who arrives in school after 9:10 will be marked as an unauthorised absence.

#### **Reception and Year 1 toilets**

We are delighted that we were successful in securing a significant amount of money to replace our Reception and KS1 toilets. Unfortunately there has been a slight delay in their completion but we have been assured today that they will all be fully operational by Monday morning. Both our Reception and Year 1 children have been very mature and sensible whilst the alternative arrangements have been put in place.

#### **School Forms**

t the beginning of each school year we need to ensure that all of our pupil information is up to date and accurate and as a consequence there are a number of forms that we have emailed to you this week. Please return these by Wednesday 13th September.

The following three forms are completed annually:

- Medicine Care Plan
- Food Allergies
- Asthma Care Plan

If you are new to Oakridge you will need to fill in two additional forms which ensure consent for the time that your child is at Oakridge unless you inform the school otherwise. These are electronic forms sent by ParentMail. We will be sending these out next week:

- Photo consent
- Local visits consent

We are very aware of the administration that is involved, however we are legally obliged to obtain this information and we thank you all in advance for supporting the process.

#### Year 1








#### Year 2
