Is my child too ill for school?

As you will have seen from last weeks newsletter the Government has a very strong focus on school attendance. This week we have received a letter from the DfE written by Professor Chris Whitty, Chief Medical Officer, England offering guidance which we have copied for your information below.

As you begin to welcome children and young people back for a new school year, we have been asked by the Department for Education (DfE) to provide you with a clinical and public health perspective on mild illnesses and school attendance.

We are aware that the COVID-19 pandemic may have caused some parents to feel less confident with assessing whether their child is well enough to be in school so we have laid out some information which we hope you will find helpful.

There is wide agreement among health professionals and educational professionals that school attendance is vital to the life chances of children and young people. Being in school improves health, wellbeing and socialisation throughout the life course. The greatest benefits come from children and young people attending school regularly.

It is usually appropriate for parents and carers to send their children to school with mild respiratory illnesses. This would include general cold symptoms: a minor cough, runny nose or sore throat. However, children should not be sent to school if they have a temperature of 38°C or above. We would encourage you to share the <a href="NHS 'Is my child too ill for school?" guidance with

parents and carers in your schools and communities which has further information.
