Below are some promo photos to give you an idea of what 'Tread' deliver.









e will **not** be formally issuing tickets, for any of our Nativity performances, but we do ask for a £2 donation towards costumes, performance licences etc on the door.




Polite Notice

KS2 Christmas Carol Concert

This year Key Stage 2 are holding their Christmas Carol Concert at Holy Trinity Church, Baswich Lane on Thursday 21st December at **6.30pm**. All KS2 children are taking part. It should be a very exciting evening.

Arrangements on the evening:

All children should arrive at the church hall at 6.15pm.

They must wear school uniform – but no sweatshirts please – as it will be too hot.

The concert should last about an hour. Please make arrangements for your child to be picked up after the concert.

Please can we kindly ask all parents not to bring young children as the concert is not suitable for young children to attend.

Admittance to the Carol Concert is by ticket only. These can be purchased via ParentPay from early next at a cost of £3.50 each and are limited to 2 tickets per family. Anyone who arrives with additional family members who do not have a ticket will not be admitted into the Church and will be turned away. Extra children will not be permitted to sit on a parent's knee as there will simply will not be enough space.

On Thursday 21st, the children will be rehearsing at Church all day. We will be leaving school at 9:15am and returning to school for 3:15pm. Children will walk down to the Church on the Thursday morning and will be closely supervised; if it is raining they will need waterproofs.

Parents can, if they wish, pick their child up at 2:30pm from the church if they have completed the ParentMail form that will be issued on Monday. We will not be able to send children home with other parents unless we have been informed beforehand. Children will also not be allowed to walk home by themselves from the church.

The vicar has made the church hall available for us to eat our lunch so please remember on Thursday that your child will need a packed lunch and a drink. Please remember to cancel any meal or tuck orders beforehand.

Year 5/6 District Basketball Competition

n Wednesday Oakridge took part in the first ever District Basketball competition at Alleyne's Sports Centre in Stone. There were 6 schools involved with each school playing against each other once in a group format to determine the four team's that would qualify for the semi-finals. After their 5 games Oakridge won 3, drew 1 and lost 1 meaning they would qualify for a semi-final match against Walton Priory Middle. The semi-final was a very tight affair which finished 2-2 and went into extra-time where unfortunately Walton Priory scored 2 quick baskets to win 6-2. Oakridge went on to play a 3rd place play-off against Barnfields which Oakridge won 10-0 to gain the bronze medal position. Well done to all the boys and girls who took part and displayed excellent skill, determination and teamwork in what was a really enjoyable event.



Brass Tuition

The children who are currently in Year 4 have now been receiving Brass tuition for two terms the cost of this has been partly covered by a grant that we received from Staffordshire Muisc Service. The whole class lessons will finish before we break-up for Christmas.

If your child has enjoyed learning to play either a cornet, trumpet or trombone and would like to continue they may do so. Mr Walker, their teacher, will be taking small group lessons at a cost of around £100 for the two terms; this can be paid in 2 instalments.
