This is now 'live' on ParentPay.






Pantomime Visit

Children will walk down to the Church on the Thursday morning and will be closely supervised; if it is raining they will need waterproofs.


Parents can, if they wish, pick their child up at 2:30pm from the church if they have completed the ParentMail form sent to you yesterday.
