### What do we spend the additional funding on at Oakridge Primary School?

The DfE states that it is for schools to decide how the Pupil Premium is spent as they recognise that we are, 'best placed to assess what additional provision should be made for the individual pupils within their responsibility'. (DfE April 2012)

### Objectives in spending PPG:

At Oakridge Primary School, we have used our Pupil Premium to help raise attainment and achievement of our pupils through:

- Reduce class sizes by ensuring all classes have a highly qualified Teaching Assistant supporting the learning
- Securing more TA hours to run intervention programmes and support in class
- Run programme of 1 to 1 intervention programmes

- Training on intervention programmes for TAs (and associated costs)
- Ensuring that pupils have equal access to the curriculum
